RACE EQUALITY POLICY

This policy should be read in conjunction with the Equal Opportunity Policy.

At St Lawrence School:

- * pupils and staff respect differences between people and make the school a place where everyone, irrespective of race, colour, ethnic or national origin, feels welcomed and valued
- * there exists a caring Christian ethos that actively promotes tolerance and understanding
- * opportunities are taken within the curriculum to foster children's learning and understanding of racial issues
- * there is total opposition to all forms of racism, racial prejudice and racial harassment
- * staff report any incident of racist bullying or harassment to the Head Teacher who then deals appropriately with the matter and maintains a written record. Reports are made to the Governing Body and Local Education Office
- * where necessary, a specific programme of education is planned and implemented to address serious and/or repeated occurrences.
