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Dear Parents/Carers

During our Dinosaurs and Dragons topic, we will be learning about classifying different animals. On Wednesday 27th February the children have the opportunity to participate in an educational workshop called 'Fur, Feathers and Scales' at Drusillas Park in Alfriston. We will need to leave school promptly at 9.00am so please make sure your child arrives by 8.45am. We will aim to return in time for the end of the normal school day.

The cost of the trip will be £13.50. We need to ask for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of the transport and other expenses. **If you pay online, we will take this as consent for your child to take part in the trip and as your agreement to the terms set out in the attached consent form. You will not need to complete the consent form.** If paying by cash/cheque, please return the attached consent form in an envelope labelled "Drusillas Park" and place it in the trips box in the school office. If there has been any change to the medical or contact details that the school already holds for your child, please contact us immediately in order that we can update our records before the trip.

Although the contribution is voluntary, we need to point out that we do need contributions in order for the trip to go ahead. No child will be treated differently if a contribution is not forthcoming. We appreciate that some families may find it particularly difficult to contribute all or part of the suggested sum and no child will be treated differently if this is the case. If you feel that you are in such a position, please do not hesitate to contact us in confidence to discuss whether some suitable arrangements can be made to cover the cost of your child's participation.


All children will need a packed lunch. If your child normally has a school lunch, you will need to provide a packed lunch to take on the trip. Please ensure that your children are equipped with appropriate clothing to spend the day outdoors, with a backpack containing lunch and a drink in a plastic bottle.

If your child suffers with travel sickness, please ensure he/she has been given the necessary medication before leaving home. If medication is required at school before setting off or for the return journey, you will need to complete a medical form which can be obtained from the School Office. Please put the medication inside a named envelope or other suitable container and staple it to the form, which should then be given to the first aider accompanying the trip.

We will need a small number of parent helpers with a valid DBS disclosure to join us on this trip. Please let your child's teacher know if you are able to help. Please also inform us if your child has an allergic reaction to any animals.
