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Dear Parents

The Foundation Stage is planning to visit Washbrooks Farm Centre on Tuesday 26th March 2019. We will walk there and back so there will be no transport costs. The cost to cover entrance to Washbrooks will be £6.00 per child. We need to ask for a voluntary contribution towards the cost of this trip. If your child has a Washbrooks pass, there is no charge – however the attached consent form is still required. Please give your child's pass to his/her teacher on the day.

If you pay online, we will take this as consent for your child to take part in the trip and as your agreement to the terms set out in the attached consent form. You will not need to complete the consent form. If paying by cash/cheque, please return the attached consent form in an envelope labelled "Washbrooks Farm" and place it in the trips box in the school office. If there has been any change to the medical or contact details that the school already holds for your child, please contact us immediately in order that we can update our records before the trip.

Although the contribution is voluntary, we do need to point out that we need contributions in order for the trip to go ahead. We appreciate that some families may find it particularly difficult to contribute all or part of the suggested sum and no child will be treated differently if this is the case. If you feel that you are in such a position, please do not hesitate to contact us in confidence to discuss whether some suitable arrangements can be made to cover the cost of your child's participation.

The children will spend most of the day outside, so please ensure they wear sensible and comfortable shoes and that they have a waterproof coat with a hood. Children do not need to be in full uniform but please could they wear their school sweatshirt/cardigan. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink in a clearly named lunch box. During the morning, there will be an opportunity for children to have a mid morning snack. We will take school fruit for this.

We will need a small number of parent helpers with a valid DBS disclosure to join us on this trip. Please let your child's teacher know if you are able to help. Please also inform us if your child has an allergic reaction to any animals. We look forward to a fun and exciting first school trip on what we hope will be a dry day!
